The team is specially trained to handle delicate situations and are comfortable engaging and photographing very ill children and their families. They treat each family with compassion, dignity and respect while providing them with priceless photographs free of charge that they might not otherwise have the opportunity to receive. Families caring for a sick child are often financially devastated and cannot afford professional photography services. With the opening of the new space, the non-profit is projecting to serve at least 250-300 families in the next 12 months, if funding is there to support that goal.
