The folks at Urban Brew and BBQ have tackled another food style — southern comfort food. They've refurbished an abandoned gas station in the district and added an awning that will cover the brewery equipment, as well as about 100 seats. By early fall Historic Kenwood will be home to the only brewpub in the city of St. Pete. Cocktails will also be available with a slight focus on whiskeys. No dish will be replicated from Urban BBQ. Notables to try are the fried chicken, seasonal cobblers, homemade ice creams, and fresh gulf shrimp cakes. They'll use house-cured bacon and pork rinds made from scratch. Urban Comfort will also be one of the few places in town, outside of the St. Pete Shuffleboard Club, where you can play a game of shuffleboard. Four courts will be located in front of the building along Central Ave and will be open to the public to enjoy.
